

Chinese exports soar despite US tariffs

Chinese exports soared in April – defying analysts' forecasts after the introduction of wide-ranging U.S. tariffs – putting pressure on the U.S. ahead of trade negotiations starting on May 10 in Geneva

U.S. tariffs up to 145%



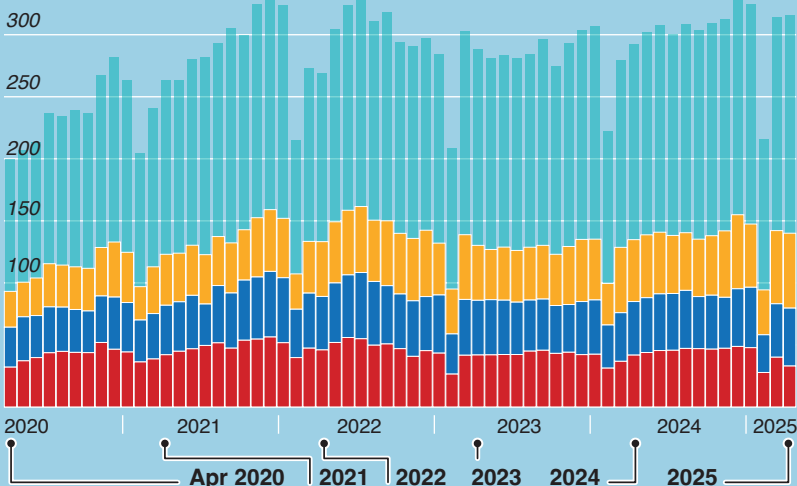
IMPORTS: Down 0.2%
