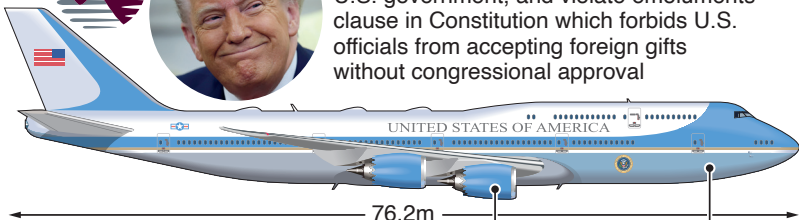


Trump plans to accept luxury 747 from Qatar

The Qatari royal family is discussing donating a \$400m jumbo jet to the Trump administration that would be outfitted to serve as Air Force One – and President Trump's personal plane after he leaves office



Qatar's **Boeing 747-8i** could become one of most valuable gifts ever received by U.S. government, and violate emoluments clause in Constitution which forbids U.S. officials from accepting foreign gifts without congressional approval

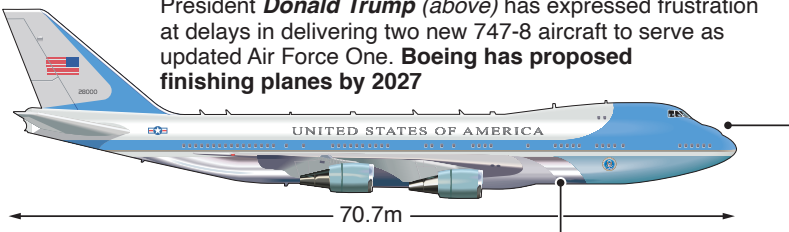

Two planes have been in use since 1990 and 1991

Defence: Hardened to withstand electromagnetic pulse of nuclear blast, counter measures to jam enemy radar
