

Europe's "Super Sunday" election results

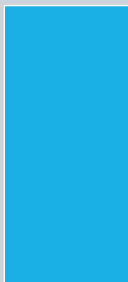

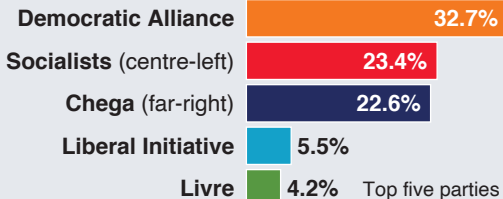
