

The new UK-EU agreement at a glance

The UK and European Union have reached a deal setting out post Brexit relations on areas including fishing rights, trade and defence



FISHING RIGHTS

EU boats given access to UK waters until 2038

- UK will continue to agree annual quotas with EU and Norway and issue licences to control who fishes in its waters

- UK seafood sector to get **£360m** fund to invest in new technology and equipment



FOOD EXPORTS

“Vast majority” of routine checks on animal and plant shipments to and from EU will be dropped – including between UK and Northern Ireland

- New food safety agreement means products such as raw burgers and sausages can be sold back into EU for first time since Brexit

- UK expected to follow EU rules it does not write – overseen by **European Court of Justice**



DEFENCE AND SECURITY

Set up of formal UK-EU pact. Officials to meet for defence talks every six months

- Both sides to explore potential for UK to gain access to **€150bn** EU fund for defence procurement



YOUTH MOBILITY SCHEME

Further talks on deal allowing young people to work and travel freely between UK and EU

- UK to work towards rejoining **Erasmus+**, which allows students to study or do internship abroad



BORDER CONTROLS

UK citizens can use e-gates at more European airports

- New system will make it easier for UK citizens to take pets abroad



CARBON TAX

UK and EU to link carbon markets to avoid taxes on goods such as steel and cement
