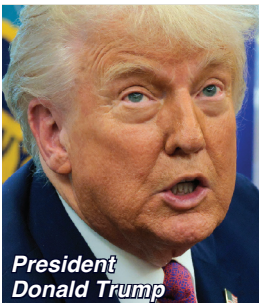


Trump executive orders face courts

The Court of International Trade in Manhattan has ruled that the implementation of wide-ranging tariffs exceeded presidential authority, following multiple other lawsuits challenging Trump's executive orders

TARIFFS

Court rules trade deficit – which U.S. has had for 49 years – is not national emergency. Tariffs otherwise require Congressional approval



TRANSGENDER MILITARY BAN

Supreme Court ruled in favour of ban, but litigation continues



BIRTHRIGHT CITIZENSHIP

Supreme Court considering appeal after federal judges block executive order

DEPORTATIONS

Deportation under ***Alien Enemies Act*** still contested, but Supreme Court rules migrants must be given time to challenge legality of removal



IMMIGRATION "PAROLE"

Judge orders resumption of processing of migrants in U.S. for humanitarian reasons, but Supreme Court revokes Venezuelans' protected status

DOGE OVERREACH

Supreme Court to rule on ***Elon Musk's*** unofficial Department of Government Efficiency accessing Social Security data illegally



FEDERAL EMPLOYEES

Injunction prevents large scale reductions in workforce but Supreme Court blocks order to rehire thousands of workers in six federal agencies

EDUCATION

Injunction granted over attempt to dismantle ***Dept of Education***. Lawsuits filed over withholding of funds, job terminations



TEACHER TRAINING GRANTS

Supreme Court allows cuts of \$600m in grants for critical teacher shortages in poor and rural communities, for "promoting divisive ideologies"

USAID

Groups sue Administration over freeze of foreign aid, dismantling of ***USAID***, destruction of records



FOREIGN AID PAYMENTS

Supreme Court releases foreign aid payments for work already done. Only Congress authorised to dismantle USAID

INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

Harvard wins temporary restraining order over ban on foreign students, 27% of total enrolment



UNIVERSITY FUNDING

Harvard files suit to restore \$3bn in federal funding, with \$100m government contracts also terminated
