

# Lee leading South Korea presidential race

Liberal frontrunner Lee Jae-myung still leads his main conservative rival Kim Moon-soo by more than 10 percentage points, even though the race has tightened ahead of the election on June 3

Advocates using fiscal policy to support economy and vows to bring to justice those involved in failed attempt to declare martial law by ousted President **Yoon Suk Yeol** in December

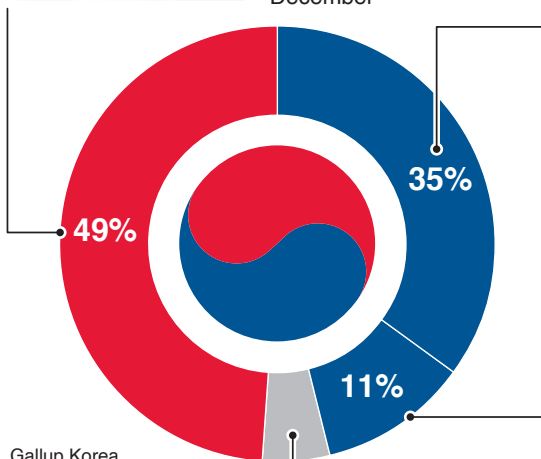
