

Verstappen dangerously close to race ban

After receiving three penalty points for causing a collision with George Russell during the Spanish Grand Prix, fiery **Max Verstappen** is on the brink of a race ban for persistent unsporting behaviour



CONTROVERSIAL POINT

Penalty points system, introduced in 2014, is designed to hold drivers accountable for their actions. Total of 12pts accumulated over one-year period equates to suspension for next race

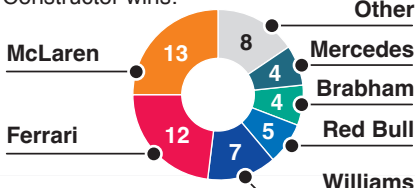
