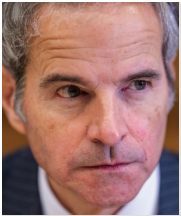


Uncertainty over Iran's missing nuclear fuel

Following the U.S. attack on three key nuclear facilities in Iran, questions remain over the fate of the Islamic republic's stockpile of near-bomb-grade uranium



■ **Jun 18:** IAEA head **Rafael Grossi** says uranium was last seen by his team of UN inspectors before Israel began striking Iran on Jun 13

■ Enriched nuclear material stored in underground complex near **Isfahan** may have been moved before U.S. strikes on Jun 22

■ IAEA assesses that Iran has enough **60%-enriched uranium** for nine nuclear bombs if it completes relatively small step to **90%**
