

U.S. halts key arms supplies to Ukraine

The Trump administration is stopping the shipment of artillery shells and air defence systems to Ukraine, leaving the country without crucial weapons as it faces intensified missile and drone strikes from Russia

Jun 29: Russian forces launch **477** drones and **60** missiles into Ukraine in biggest single nightly air raid since start of war



■ Pentagon's decision – driven by concerns over low U.S. military stockpiles – affects 30 **Patriot air defence missiles**, which Ukraine uses to intercept ballistic missiles, nearly 8,500 **155mm artillery shells**, more than 250 precision-guided **GMLRS rockets**, and 142 **Hellfire air-to-surface missiles**
