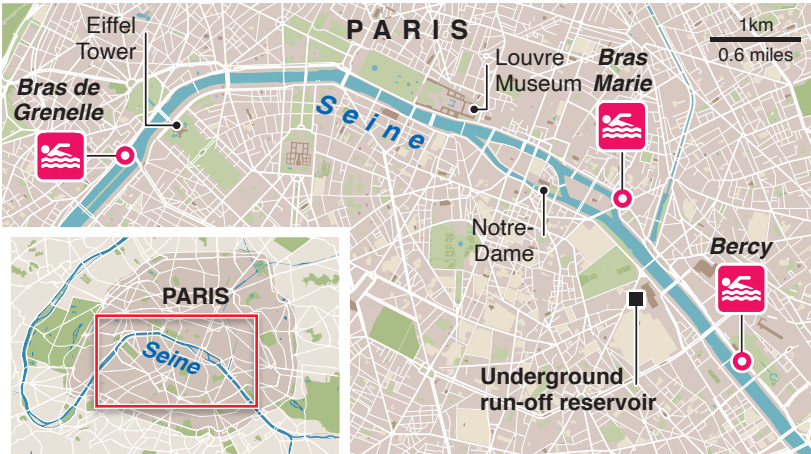


# Seine reopens for swimming after a century

The River Seine in Paris has reopened to public swimming for the first time since 1923, thanks to a major clean-up campaign prompted by its use in the 2024 Paris Olympics



Swimming sites



■ **Admission:** Open for free at scheduled times to anyone with minimum age of 10 or 14 years, depending on location, between Jul 5 and Aug 31

■ **Water quality:** \$1.65 billion invested to connect thousands of homes to sewers, upgrade treatment plants, and build rainwater reservoirs to prevent storm overflows
