

Fuel switches probed in Air India crash

The investigation on the June 12 crash of Air India flight 171 has narrowed its focus to the movement of the engine fuel control switches, according to reports



Fuel control: Two-position switches (RUN / CUTOFF) used on ground for engine start / shutdown, or in flight for manual shutdown or restart in event of engine failure

Moving switch during flight cuts off fuel supply, shutting down engine
