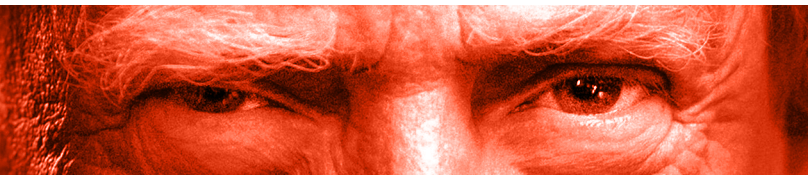


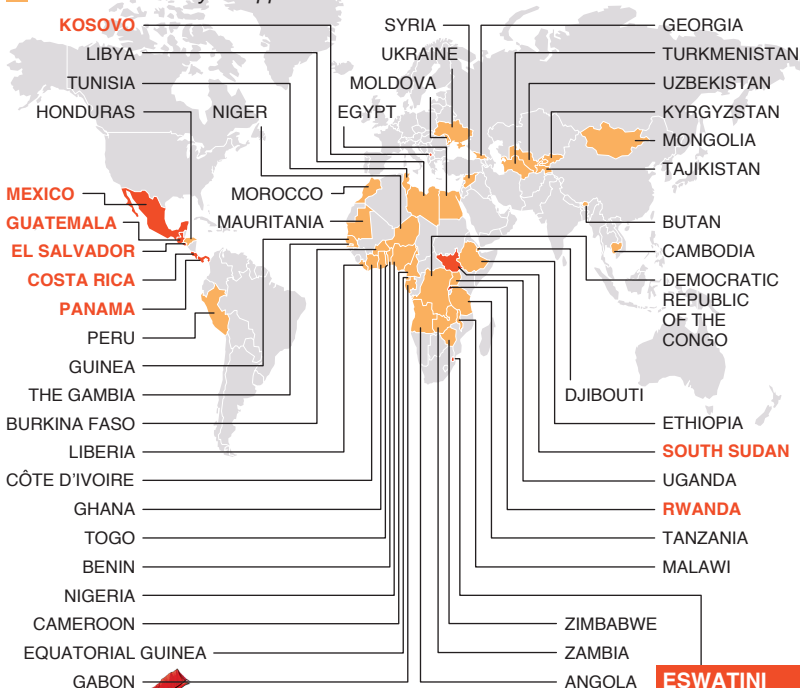
Trump eyes third-country deportations

U.S. President Trump has his eyes on third-countries to expel migrants to, usually not the country a deportee hails from, as he ramps up efforts to remove illegal immigrants from American soil



■ Have agreed to accept non-citizen deportations from U.S.

■ U.S. recently sent five immigrants it says were convicted of serious crimes to kingdom
