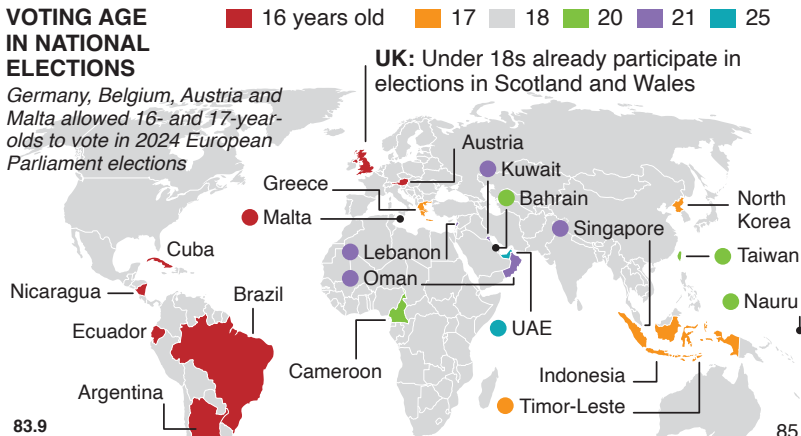


UK to lower voting age to 16

Britain is to reduce its voting age in general elections from 18 to 16, giving the country one of the lowest in the world. The proposed changes are designed to boost participation
