

Trump to build ballroom at White House

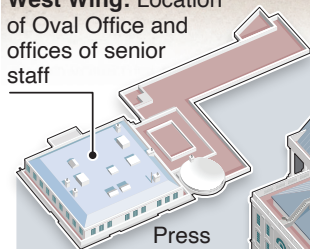
The president's long-held desire to build a ballroom – a \$200 million project – marks the most extensive alteration to the White House since Truman's 1952 renovation
