

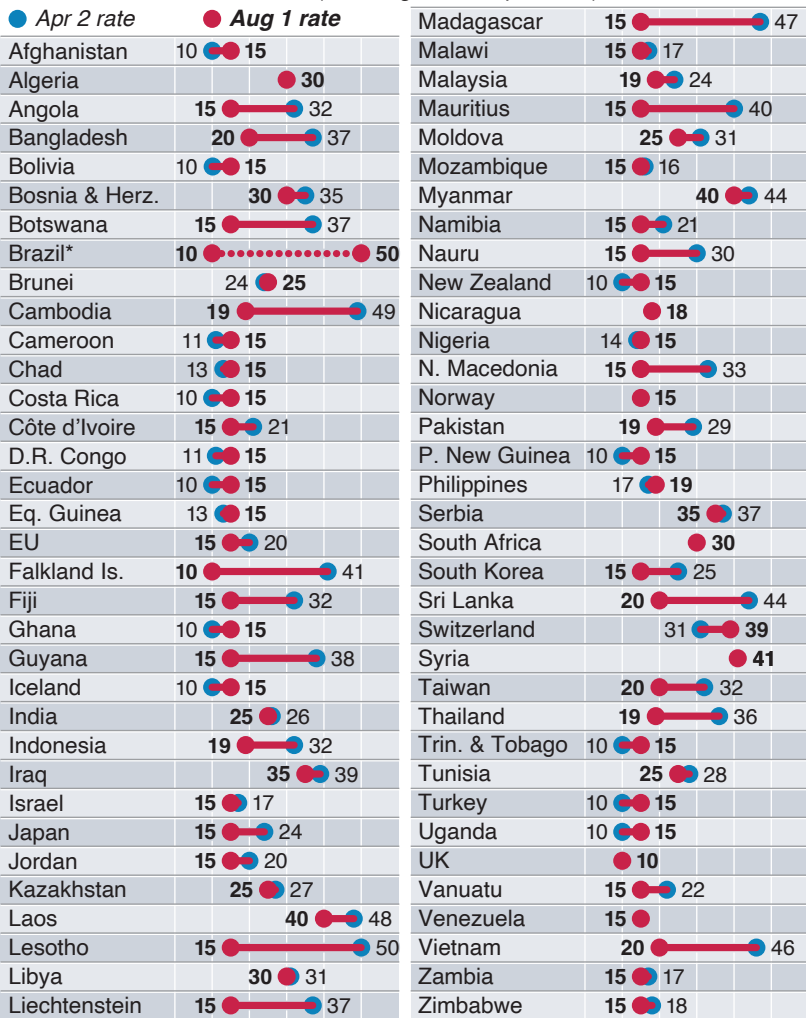
Tracking Trump's new tariffs

U.S. President Trump has released adjusted reciprocal tariff rates covering imports from a wide range of trading partners, as he steps up efforts to reorder the global economy in favour of the United States
