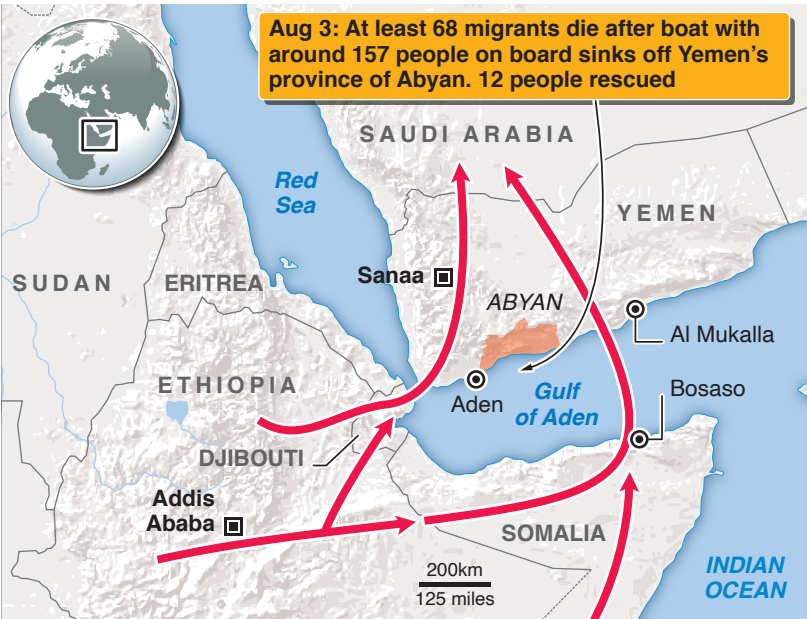


Scores of migrants die off Yemen coast

More than 140 migrants are believed dead after a boat capsized in the latest of a series of shipwrecks off Yemen that have killed hundreds fleeing poverty in hope of reaching the wealthy Gulf states

Aug 3: At least 68 migrants die after boat with around 157 people on board sinks off Yemen's province of Abyan. 12 people rescued



→ Eastern Route:

One of world's busiest and most perilous migration paths, used primarily by people from Ethiopia and Somalia seeking better opportunities in Arabian Peninsula

■ More than 3,400 people have died or disappeared along route since 2014, including over 580 women and 100 children. ***Around 1,400 of these deaths were caused by drowning***
