

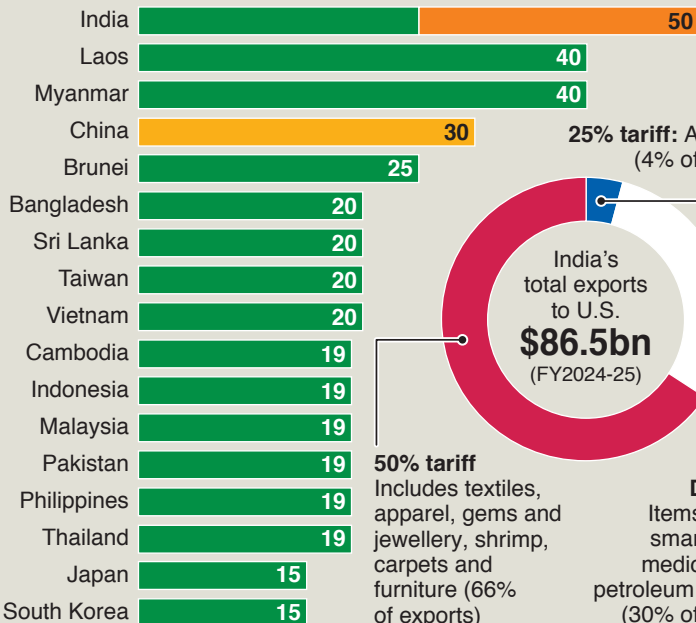
# Steep U.S. tariffs hit Indian goods

President Donald Trump has imposed a crushing 50% tariff on many Indian exports to the U.S. – the highest rate in Asia – to punish the country for its purchases of discounted Russian oil
