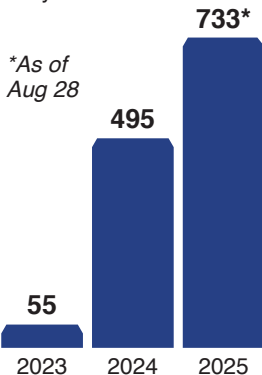


Sharp rise in GPS jamming over Baltic Sea

Sweden accuses Russia of being behind a significant rise in GPS signal jamming over the Baltic Sea, raising concerns for aviation in the region. Moscow denies the allegations
