Fox Corp CEO since 2019

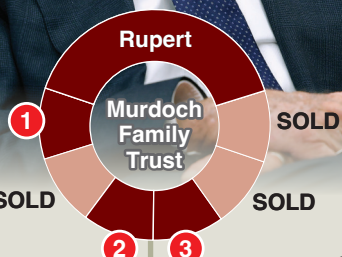
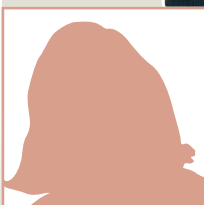
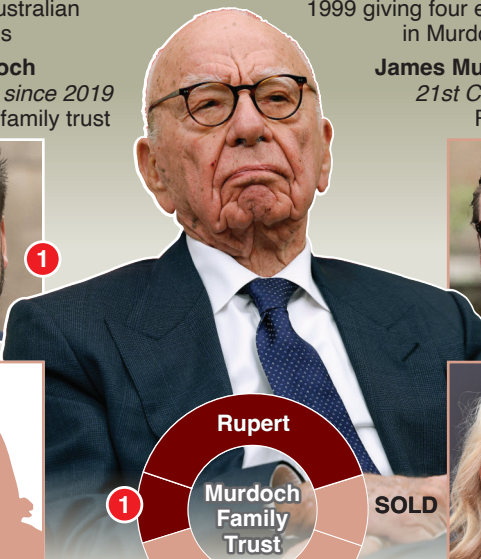
Control of new family trust

Formerly 21st Century Fox CEO

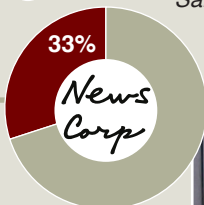
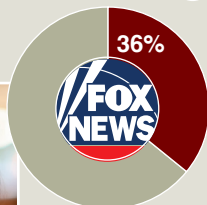
