

Farmingdale hosts 45th Ryder Cup

SEPTEMBER 26-28, BETHPAGE BLACK COURSE, NEW YORK

The Ryder Cup, first held in 1927, is golf's most electrifying stage – delivering three days of unrivalled drama as the best players from Europe and the United States clash, turning quietened greens into raucous battlegrounds. In 2023, Europe regained the trophy on dramatic final day in Rome, with Ireland's Shane Lowry securing a 16½-11½ victory



Designed by legendary architect A.W. Tillinghast. 2025 course adjustments include relocation of first tee – moving forward by 40 yards – and repositioning fairway bunker on 13th hole



Second time New York has staged Ryder Cup – Europe winning thrilling contest at Oak Hill in 1995

Ryder Cup trophy: Made of gold, and stands 17 inches tall, weighing four pounds. Commissioned by English seed merchant Samuel A. Ryder from Mappin & Webb Co. for £250

Matchplay

Traditional Ryder Cup three-day tournament features three different match formats: fourball, foursomes and singles matches

12 Players per team 28 Total matches

DAYS 1 AND 2: 16 matches

- Four-ball: Each match has two teams of two players, with everyone playing their own ball 8 matches (four per day)
- Foursomes: Two teams of two, but each pair uses one ball and players hit alternate shots 8 matches (four per day)

DAY 3: 12 matches









- Singles: One player per team. Team captains list their players from 1-12 and each then plays against his opposite number

SCORING

Match winner after 18 holes is awarded one point for their team. Both teams earn half-point if match is tied

Winner: First team to 14½ points. If scores level at 14-14, defending team retains trophy

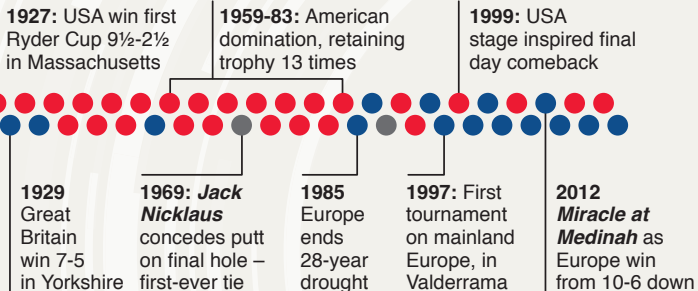
