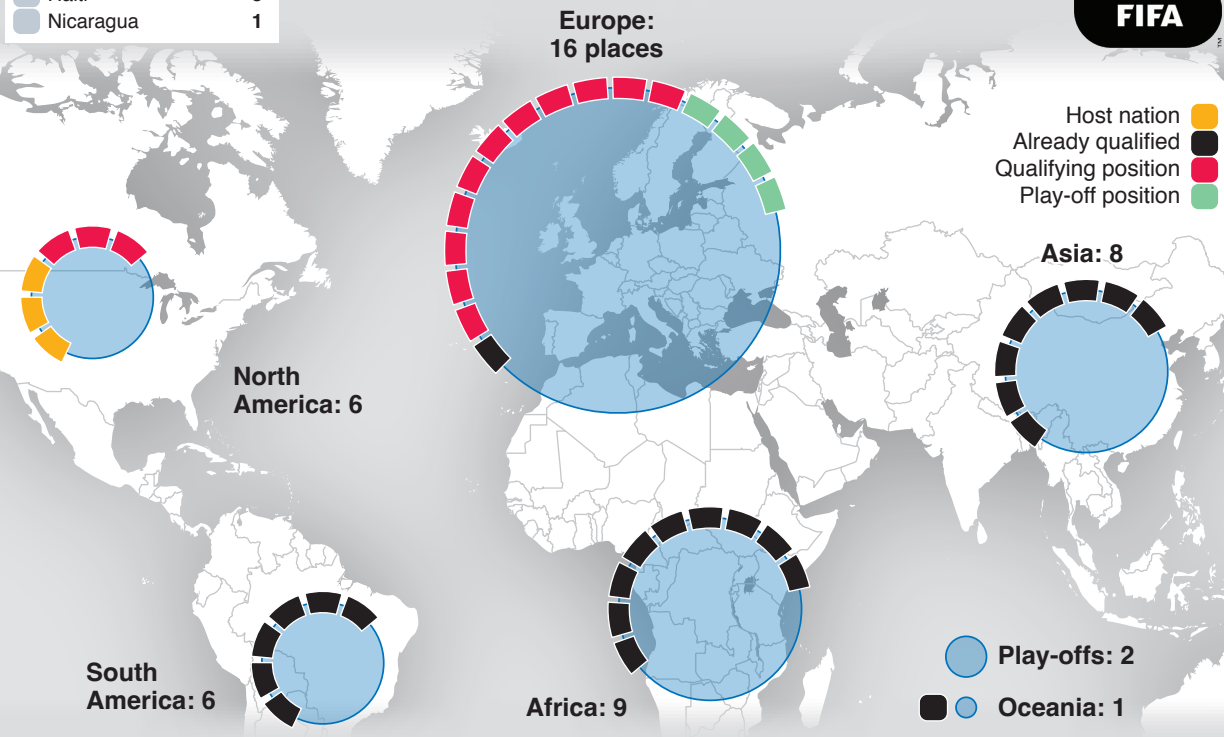


FIFA World Cup 2026 qualifiers
