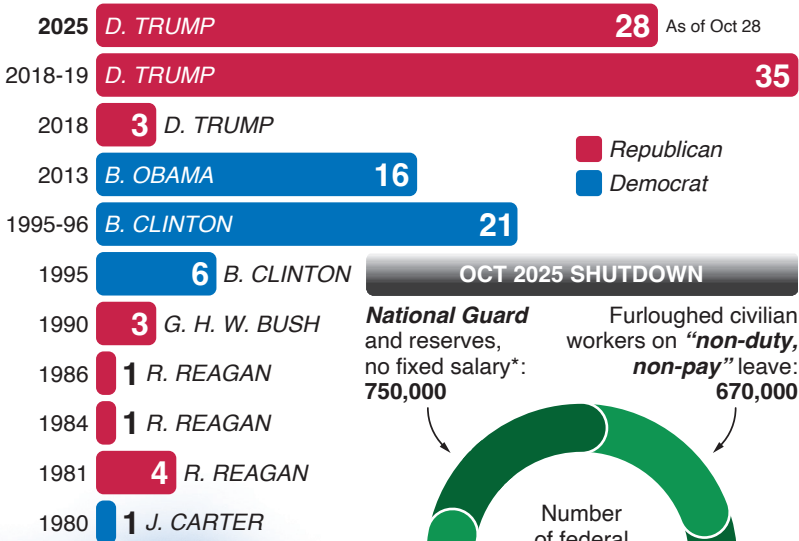


U.S. shutdown entering fifth week

Every day during October, the U.S. government has been shut down, leaving more than one million federal employees unpaid or at risk of missing pay
