

# UN Security Council backs Trump's Gaza plan

The UN Security Council has voted in favour of a U.S.-drafted resolution endorsing President Donald Trump's 20-point plan for Gaza, aimed at moving beyond the current fragile ceasefire

## KEY PROVISIONS

### SECURITY

- Authorises **International Stabilisation Force (ISF)** that will work with Israel and Egypt, along with newly trained Palestinian police force, to help secure border areas and ensure process of disarming non-state armed groups, including Hamas

- States that Israeli forces will fully withdraw once ISF has established operational control

### GOVERNANCE

- Approves creation of **Board of Peace (BoP)**, chaired by Trump, as transitional authority to oversee Gaza's reconstruction and economic recovery

- BoP will supervise technocratic, apolitical Palestinian committee responsible for day-to-day governance

### FINANCE

- Permits creation of World Bank-backed trust fund to manage reconstruction



### SELF-DETERMINATION

- Sets out pathway towards Palestinian statehood, tied to governance reforms and reconstruction progress.  
**Israel strongly opposes creation of Palestinian state**
