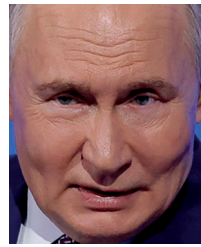
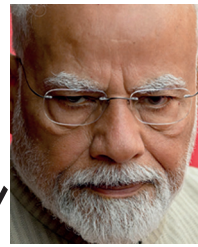

1 Dec, U.S.: The Department of Justice to release cache of documents related to disgraced financier **Jeffrey Epstein**. They are certain to contain fresh revelations about his activities and could embarrass prominent figures



2 Dec 4-5, India: Russian President **Vladimir Putin** meets **Narendra Modi** in New Delhi as the two countries continue to strengthen ties despite the Kremlin's ongoing isolation

3 Dec 18, Belgium: European Council meets to discuss proposed \$163-billion "Reparations Loan" to Ukraine based on frozen Russian state assets, the last chance this year for the EU to agree its release



4 Dec 28, Myanmar: The military government holds general elections in a phased poll widely condemned as a sham designed to perpetuate the junta's control, led by General **Min Aung Hlaing** (left)



6 Dec 10, Australia: New legislation bans under 16s from social media platforms such as **Twitter**, **Facebook**, **Instagram** and **TikTok**

5 Dec 14, Chile: Presidential election goes to a run-off vote between Communist Party's **Jeannette Jara** and far-right rival **José Antonio Kast** (pictured left)



7 Dec 25, India: **Navi Mumbai International Airport (NMIA)**, the highly anticipated second airport for India's financial capital, begins commercial operations and is expected eventually to handle up to 90 million passengers per year

8 Dec 16, England: Literary world celebrates the 250th anniversary of the birth of **Pride and Prejudice** author **Jane Austen**
