

European proposal for Ukraine peace

European hopes have been buoyed after President Trump said the U.S.-Russian plan to end the war in Ukraine was “not the final offer”, as Germany, France and Britain make key changes in a counter-proposal

EUROPEAN PROPOSAL

- 1** Negotiations on territory begin after ceasefire, starting from current frontline
- 2** Recognise Ukrainian sovereignty
- 3** **U.S. to provide security guarantee to mirror NATO Article 5**
U.S. to receive compensation

U.S.-RUSSIAN PROPOSAL

- Recognise occupied areas as Russian*
- Rollback of U.S. military assistance*



If Ukraine invades Russia, it forfeits security guarantee

- 4** **IAEA to take over Zaporizhya Nuclear Power Plant**, divide power between Moscow and Kyiv



- 5** Ukraine eligible for EU membership
 - 7** Redevelopment package to include U.S. partnership on gas infrastructure
 - 9** Joint Security taskforce to enforce agreement
 - 10** Russia-Ukraine-NATO non-aggression pact. All ambiguities from previous 30 years to be resolved
 - 11** Ukraine joining NATO is dependent on consensus which does not exist
 - 12** No NATO troops in Ukraine
 - 13** NATO fighter jets in Poland
 - 14**
- 6** Sanctions phased out. Russia to rejoin G8
- 8** Frozen Russian assets used to fund Ukraine reconstruction
- Russian-occupied territory, Nov 23
- Russia-NATO convention to de-escalate tension
- Ukraine barred from NATO
- No foreign troops in Ukraine
