

Championship set for gripping finale

The 2025 F1 season reaches a thrilling three-way conclusion in Abu Dhabi, with rivals Lando Norris, Max Verstappen and Oscar Piastri all in contention – one of the closest battles for the drivers' title in the history of the sport

DRIVERS CHAMPIONSHIP (points accumulated over 2025 season)

Lando Norris 408

Will become 11th British F1 World Champion with...

- **Podium finish**
(Finishing 1st, 2nd, 3rd)
- **Finish ahead** of both Verstappen and Piastri
- **Finish within 12pt-margin** of Verstappen, and 16pts of Piastri

Max Verstappen 396

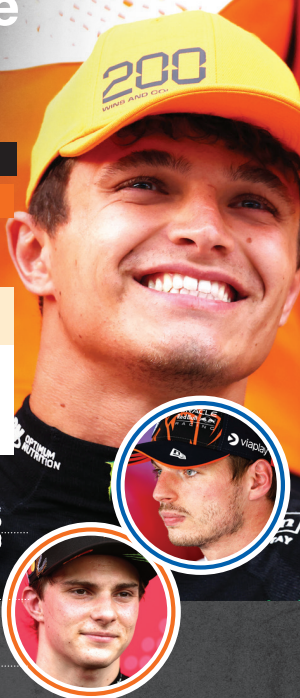
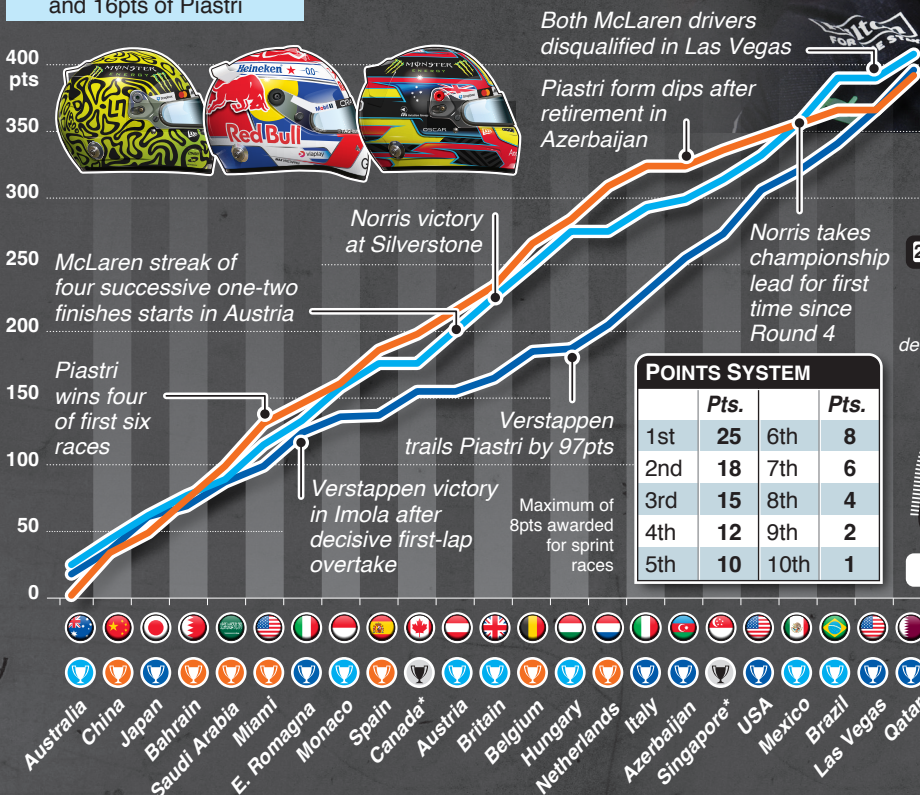
Will clinch fifth successive crown with...

- **Race win** – and Norris finishing 4th or lower
- **Leading margin** of 13pts over Norris, and finish within 4pts of Piastri

Oscar Piastri 392

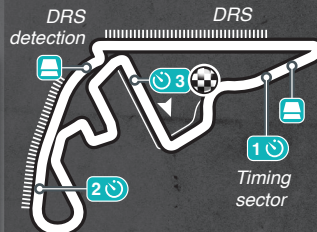
Will secure maiden F1 title with...

- **Race win** – and Norris finishing 6th or lower
- **Leading margin** of 17pts over Norris, and 5pts ahead of Verstappen
