

# Thailand-Cambodia clashes break truce

Clashes have broken out along the Thailand-Cambodia border ending the fragile ceasefire brokered by U.S. President Trump, with both countries claiming violations by the other

Fighting in July killed at least 48 people and displaced over 300,000 in both countries



## TIMELINE OF TENSIONS

- 1907:** French colony of Cambodia and Kingdom of Siam (now Thailand) sign treaty delineating border, but vague map causes ambiguity
- 2008:** Cambodia registers **Preah Vihear Temple** in disputed area as Unesco World Heritage Site
- 2011:** Troops clash at temple, at least 15 dead
- May 28, 2025:** Import bans and travel restrictions imposed after Cambodian soldier killed in **Chong Bok**
- Jul 23:** Thai soldiers injured by landmine near **Chong An Ma**. Heavy fighting erupts in multiple areas along border
- Jul 28:** Both sides agree to "immediate and unconditional ceasefire" following peace talks
- Nov 11:** Thailand suspends ceasefire after soldier maimed, accusing Cambodia of planting new mines
- Dec 7-8:** Thai F-16s strike military facilities amid claims of Cambodian rocket fire and drone attacks
