Hamas disarmament

Will only give up arms upon creation of Palestinian state

Stabilisation force

Indonesia and Pakistan could play a role, Israel opposes Turkish involvement

Technocratic government

Meant to rule for transitional period without Hamas

International Board of Peace

Chaired by Trump to oversee government, members to be confirmed 2026

Palestinian Authority

Reforms required before taking role, still unconfirmed
