

Moscow car bomb kills Russian general

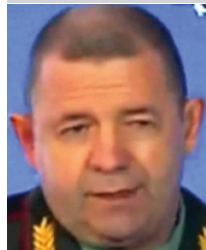
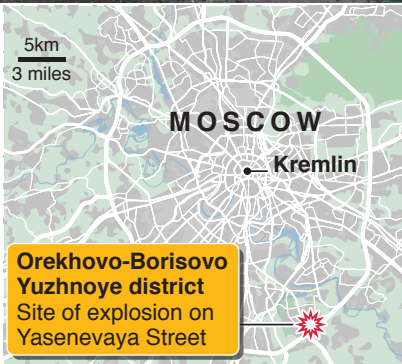
Russia's Investigative Committee is looking into whether Ukraine's intelligence services were behind a car bombing in southern Moscow that killed Lieutenant General Fanil Sarvarov



Dec 22: Fanil Sarvarov, 56, head of Russian General Staff's army operational training directorate, dies after explosive device placed under his car detonates

He previously took part in combat operations during Ossetian-Ingush conflict and Chechen wars in 1990s and early 2000s. Also led operations in Syria from 2015-16

Attack appears to be the latest targeted assassination of senior military official in Moscow
