

Evolution of the Winter Olympic Torch

The now familiar tradition of a Winter Olympic Torch Relay first began at the 1952 Oslo Games in Norway, using a relatively simple brass and steel alloy torch, which burned disposable liquid gas cartridges

2026

Made from recycled aluminium-brass alloy, and weighing just **1.06kg**, torch can be refilled up to 10 times with renewable bio-LPG

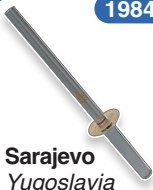

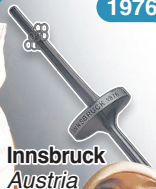
