

Two high-speed trains crash in Spain

An investigation is under way after two high-speed trains collided in southern Spain, killing at least 39 people, in the country's deadliest railway accident since 2013

Iryo train Operated by private company **Iryo** Model: **Frecciarossa 1000**
(service 6189)



Alvia train (service 2384) Operated by state-funded firm **Renfe**



Model: **Renfe Class 120**



Alvia train
Travelling from Madrid to Huelva with around 100 passengers on board at 205 km/h

First two carriages of Alvia train are hit and pushed into embankment

Iryo train
Travelling from Málaga to Madrid with around 300 passengers on board at 210 km/h

1 Last carriages of Iryo train derail, crossing over to opposite track
