



# France's new Islamic art gallery

The Louvre museum in Paris has constructed a \$131 million wing that will house precious artworks gathered from all over the Islamic world

Completed by Napoleon III in 1857, it is now home to **Department of Islamic Art** and its 18,000 exhibits



## Design

Based on “flying carpet” it occupies two floors – one below ground
