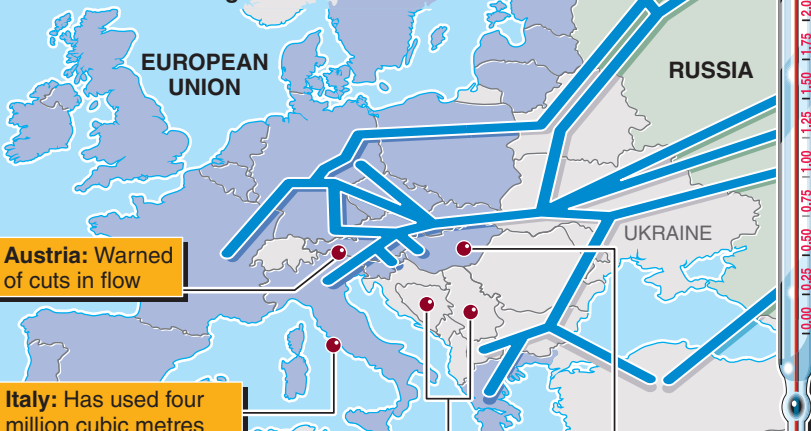


Severe Russian winter cuts gas to Europe

Russia's state-controlled energy giant Gazprom has reduced supplies to European customers due to soaring domestic consumption caused by the harshest winter in a generation



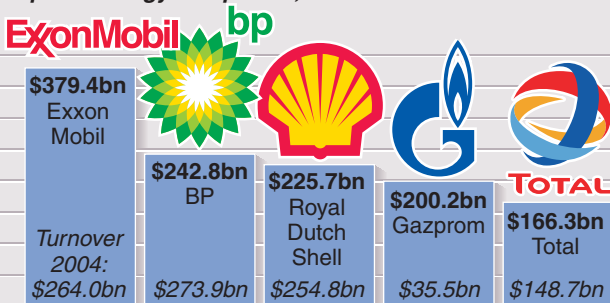
Austria: Warned of cuts in flow

Italy: Has used four million cubic metres from own reserves due to 5% fall in supply

Bosnia, Serbia: Facing cuts of 20-25 percent

Hungary: Supply cut by 8bn m³ to 31bn m³
