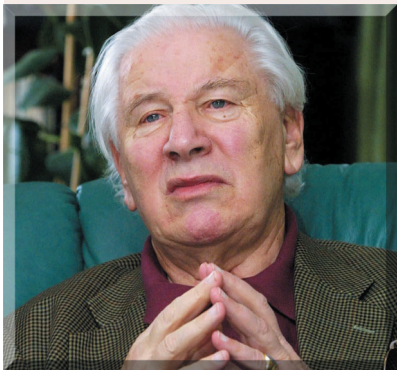

▲ **2004:** Multi-talented actor Sir Peter Ustinov died at the age of 82

**1483:** Renaissance master Raphael was born Raffaello Santi in Urbino, Italy

**1797:** U.S. inventor Nathaniel Briggs patented a washing machine

**1910:** The first seaplane took off near Marseilles, France

**1939:** Madrid fell to Franco's forces, ending the Spanish Civil War

**2005:** An 8.5 earthquake off Sumatra killed 1,300 people, mostly on the island of Nias. The tremor caused mass panic as people feared a repeat of the deadly tsunamis that followed the nearby quake of December 26
