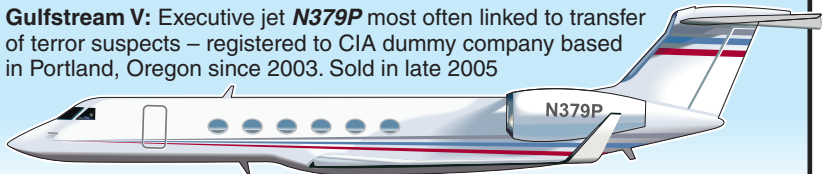


Further claims of CIA prison flights

A new report from Amnesty International claims to provide further evidence that eastern European countries may have been involved in secret CIA flights carrying terror suspects to so-called “black site” prisons for detention and interrogation at various times since 2001

Gulfstream V: Executive jet **N379P** most often linked to transfer of terror suspects – registered to CIA dummy company based in Portland, Oregon since 2003. Sold in late 2005
