**1656:** Charles X of Sweden defeated the Poles at the Battle of Warsaw

1889: Vladimir Zworykin, often called "the father of television" for his invention of the iconoscope, was born in Murom, Russia

**1980:** The Republic of Vanuatu gained independence from France and Britain
