

▶ 1970s: Member of *Darul Islam* – militant group attempting to establish

Islamic state in Indonesia. Jailed for subversion by *Suharto* regime

1985: Flees to Malaysia to escape further prison sentence

▶ 1999: Returns to Indonesia after fall of Suharto. Becomes teacher at Islamic school in central Java

Oct 2002: Arrested in aftermath of Bali bomb attacks which kill 202

Sep 2003: Acquitted of leading Jemaah Islamiah terror group but stays in jail on immigration offences

► Apr 2004: Re-arrested on release, charges include involvement in conspiracy behind Bali bombings

➤ Mar 2005: Sentenced to 30 months in jail – later reduced by four months in Indonesia's regular Independence Day remission programme

Jun 14, 2006: Bashir, 67, to be freed from Jakarta's Cipinang jail
