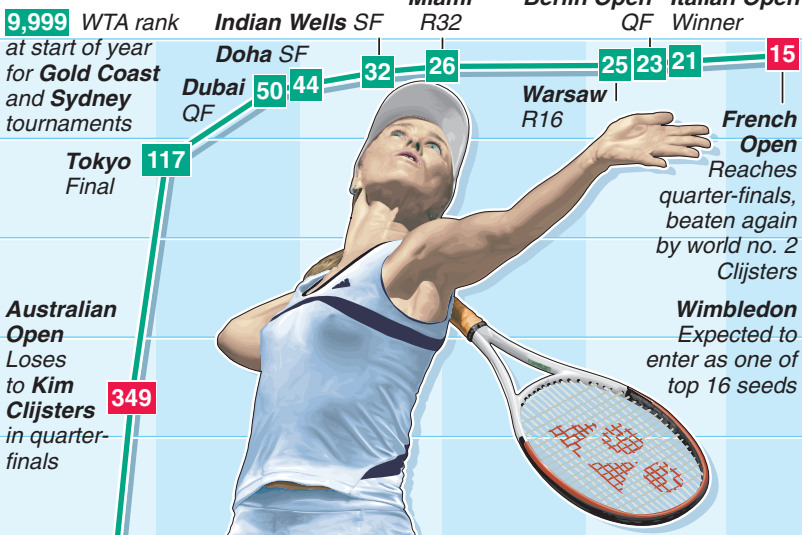


Former champion reaches for past heights
