
## Rising below vulgarity



## ▶ Born: June 28, 1926, in Brooklyn.

- New York, as Melvin Kaminsky
- Serves as corporal in U.S. Army in North Africa during World War II
- Starts out in show business as stand-up comic before moving into comedy writing for television
- Moves into film as actor, director, writer and producer on popular films such as Young Frankenstein and Blazing Saddles (both 1974)
- Adapts 1968 film The Producers into hugely successful Broadway musical in 2001. Show wins 12 Tony awards, breaking 37-year record of 10 held by Hello, Dolly!
- Married to second wife, actress Anne Bancroft, from 1964 until her death in June 2005
- One of few entertainers to win Oscar, Emmy, Grammy and Tony Awards - including Oscar for Best Screenplay (The Producers, 1968), and Tonys for Best Musical, Book and Original Score (The Producers, 2001)
