

Brit flicks set box office record

British films were seen by 600 million people around the world in 2005. The top 20 performing British-American co-productions grossed a record \$3.3 billion worldwide with a market share of 14.3% – compared with 10.3% in 2004 – despite a 9% fall in global cinema revenue
