

# UN aims for advance Lebanon force

The United Nations is trying to get an advance force of peacekeepers into Lebanon in 10-15 days. The force of up to 3,500-strong, will be boosted later to the full 15,000 agreed in the UN ceasefire resolution



**LEBANON:** Plans to send 15,000 troops, but major disagreements in Cabinet on disarming Hezbollah



Israeli Defence Force troops in Lebanon



Israeli forces and Hezbollah to withdraw from area between Litani and border



Hezbollah killed 165-565

IDF killed 118

**1 IDF:** To pullout first from north-east, followed by **2** pullout from south-west **UNIFIL:** Existing UN international force of 2,000 to coordinate Israeli pullout and arrival of Lebanese forces



**France:** Currently commands UNIFIL force, could provide up to 5,000 troops



**Spain, Portugal:** Evaluating 700-800 troop contribution



**Italy:** Ready to send up to 3,000 fully-armed from all services including special forces



**Malaysia:** Could send 800-1,000 troops



**Norway:** 100 marines, 4 boats  
**Finland:** 100-200 troops

**Australia, Indonesia, Ireland, New Zealand, Turkey:** May contribute troops. **Denmark:** Navy ship
