

United Nations peace plan timeline

UN planners have laid out a timeline for deploying as many as 15,000 additional soldiers to its peacekeeping force UNIFIL in southern Lebanon to enforce a cease-fire between Israel and Hezbollah. Some 3,000 Lebanese army troops have crossed south of the strategic Litani River

REINFORCING UNIFIL PEACEKEEPERS

Sep 2: Deployment of 3,500 troops including three mechanized infantry battalions (850 men each); one light reconnaissance battalion (600 men) plus engineers, signals, military police and HQ companies

Oct 5: Addition of hospital, five helicopters, three infantry battalions; two reconnaissance battalions; engineering battalion; two signals companies

Nov 4: Complete deployment of all 15,000 peacekeepers and IDF withdrawal
