

Middle-East war by the numbers

LEBANON

845 Number of people killed, including 743 civilians, 34 soldiers, 68 Hezbollah. Israel says it killed about 530 guerrillas

4,051 People wounded

916,000 Or about one-fourth of total Lebanese population

4,500 Israeli bombing raids reported by Lebanese officials

15,000 Houses or individual apartments, plus about 900 commercial buildings. 650km of roads and 80 bridges also destroyed

\$9.4bn In damage, including \$3.5bn to infrastructure; \$180m to electricity grid; \$70m to water system

75% Of people unable to work because of fighting. Hundreds of millions of dollars in tourism revenue also lost
